

STATEMENT OF INTEREST TO OBTAIN THE AUTHORIZATION TO USE THE DENOMINATION OF ORIGIN (DO), REGIONAL DENOMINATION OF ORIGIN (DOR), PROTECTED GEOGRAPHICAL INDICATION (PGI)



It is a legal protection, distinct within the field of industrial property, based on indications of origin. This protection applies to agricultural and/or food products, such as Colombian coffee, where the specific geographic name indicates its origin and its quality is directly linked to that origin. This is a legal requirement in the Andean Community of Nations (CAN), which includes Colombia, Ecuador, Peru, and Bolivia.



It is a legal protection regulated by the European Commission (EU) for products that are grown, manufactured, or processed in a specific territory or region, with quality directly linked to their origin and transformation processes, such as Colombian coffee. This is a legal requirement in the European Union, Switzerland, and the United Kingdom.
